Global Invasive Species Programme

Globalisation means more goods are being transported between more countries, more quickly.

This puts increasing pressure on the quarantine systems that manage these goods in the country of origin and receiving country and can substantially complicate efforts to stop the movement of invasive species through trade.

Invasive species enter countries in many different ways. It is important for countries to understand these pathways and manage the risks that each poses.

International guidance on mitigating the risks is needed and should be developed with relevant international agencies and trade-related bodies, such as the World Trade Organisation.
